Probability Vocabulary

- 1. Probability- The measure of how likely an event will occur.
- 2. Experiment- any activity involving chance.
- 3. Outcome- the result of an experiment.
- 4. Event- a set of one or more outcomes.
- 5. Experimental Probability- the number of times an event OCCURS to the total number of trials. $\frac{\# occurred}{total \#}$
- 6. Theoretical probability- the number of ways that the event CAN occur, divided by the total number of outcomes. $\frac{ways\ CAN\ occur}{total\ \#}$
- 7. Trial- the times that an experiment is carried out.
- 8. Sample space- collection of results.
